

COMPETITION CHEERLEADING RULES AND REGULATIONS - LEAGUE SEASON 2011-2012

A. Competition Dates

1. There will be four (4) competitions per school during the following weeks as arranged by the host school:
 - o January 23 - 27, 2012
 - o January 30 - February 3, 2012
 - o February 6 - 10, 2012
 - o February 13 - 17, 2012
2. The Host School's Athletic Director **must** confirm dates and times of the competition.

B. RIIL Competitions - Host School Responsibility

1. five (5) **officials to be provided by the RIIL**
2. **officials' payment:** Sixty (\$60.00) dollars per official x 5 officials = \$300.00 **and one (1) of the five will serve as head official to receive additional** twenty (\$20.00) dollars = **TOTAL \$320.00**
3. **gate receipts** will hopefully be used to cover official fees.
4. provide **sound system/music**
5. have **mats ready for warm-up 60 minutes** before the actual start of the meet
6. **tabulator (1) to be provided by host school**
7. **timer (1) to be provided by host school**
8. **score sheets** will be provided by the RIIL

C. Conduct of League Meet

1. Warm-ups will begin at 6:30PM or one (1) hour prior to the start time.
2. Each team will have five (5) minutes to warm-up.
3. Rotation for meets will be done by lottery at the Interpretation Meeting and will determine the warm-up rotation.
4. Each team will perform their routine one (1) time.

D. Reporting of Competition Results

1. **Host team will fax a copy of the team scores to Gail Lepore at the RIIL (272-9838)** and call the Providence Journal (277-7340 or Fax 277-7444) with results.
2. Remember: Final team score totals at all four (4) meets will be used to seed the RIIL Competition Team Championship.

E. Other

1. Twelve (12) venues would be needed per season to act as a host.
Please inform the RIIL Director of Competition Cheerleading if you would like to host next year.
2. All teams **must** compete in all four (4) meets. The RIIL does not accept forfeits.
3. Visiting schools are reminded to leave in ample time to be at the host school.

F. Competition Cheerleading

1. Cap is twelve (12) meets, excluding the State meet.
