COMPETITION CHEERLEADING PENALTIES



1. MAJOR PENALTY: Any violation of the NFHS Spirit Rules Book
 - 5 point per infraction

2. MINOR PENALTY: Any violation of the RIIL Competition Rules listed below:
 - 2 point per infraction
 - a) Tumbling or Stunting off the mat (stepping off is legal).
 - b) Each fall where the top person’s torso and /or head strikes the mat.
 - c) Prone landings (from dismounts).
 - d) Each tumbling skill where the cheerleader strikes their head, neck or face against the mat.
 - e) Each time a tumbler kicks, strikes or tumbles into another cheerleader.

Penalties assessed are per infraction irrespective of the number of penalty judges assigned to the tournament/competition. (example: Inverted flyer infraction is -5 point whether one or more panel of line judges or penalty judges).

Emphasis on the following NFHS Rules Violations:

Rule 2-3-3 (page 18). The hair must be worn in a manner to minimize risk for the participant. Hair devices, if worn, must be secure and appropriate for the activity. Should hair device/piece/attachment fall to the mat a penalty will be assessed if a cheerleader should then step on the hair device. No penalty is assessed if a cheerleader attempts to push/pickup/move the hair device from the mat to avoid cheerleaders from stepping on it.

Rule 2-1-4 /5 (page 16). Performing surfaces must be suitable and free from objects. When discarding props (signs, etc) that are made of solid material, or have corners or sharp edges, team members must gently toss or place the props. Unsafe discarding of Props, signs, poms. Props, signs, poms must not be tossed wildly off the performing surface.
